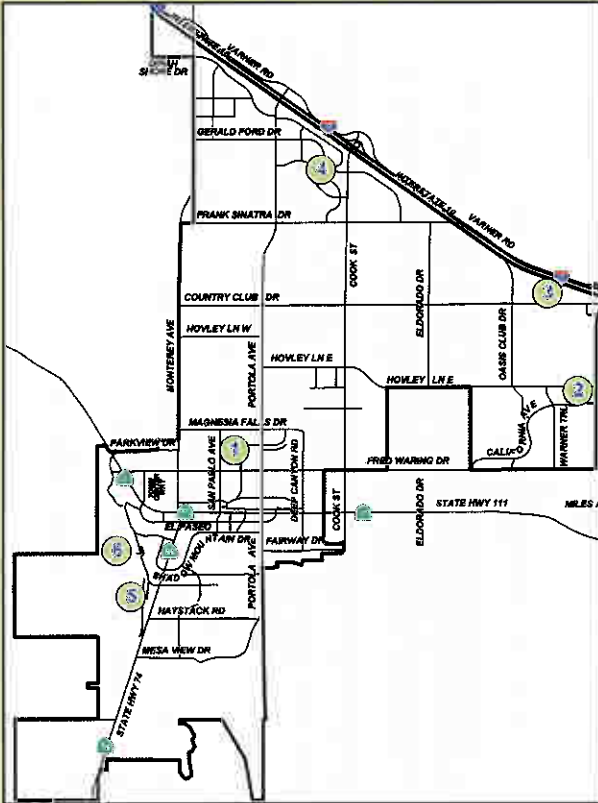

About the Dog Parks

The dog parks are open dawn to 11:00 p.m. unless otherwise noted.

Fenced Dog Parks:

Each fenced dog park consists of two fenced dog areas: one for small dogs (less than 25 lbs.) and one for larger dogs.

City of Palm Desert Ordinance: Duty to Care for Animals (No. 11.01.120)

A. Dogs or cats must be led by a cord or chain not more than six feet long or properly confined within the interior of a vehicle, except:



1. When dogs which have been specially trained and are being used by blind or disabled persons to aid and guide them in their movements.
2. When dogs are within the boundaries of the dog parks and not posing a threat to other animals, persons or property.



3. Small pets that are kept on the person of the possessor at all times.
4. Cap Homme/Ralph Adams Park and Cahuilla Hills Park are designated as "under immediate voice control" parks.

B. It is the mandatory duty of all persons owning, possessing, in control of or otherwise responsible for a dog, cat or an equine animal in a city park to promptly collect, pick up and remove all fecal matter left behind by said animal in or upon the park.

Dog Park Rules

-  Dogs must never be left unattended.
-  All dogs must wear current license.
-  Owners are required to clean up after their dogs in all areas of all parks.
-  Unruly dogs are not allowed.
-  Female dogs in heat are not allowed in fenced dog areas.
-  Dogs must be on leash at all times when outside the fenced dog areas.



-  Use of the dog park is at your own risk. This includes, but is not limited to being bitten, being knocked down, tripping, etc.
-  More than two dogs per owner is not permitted.
-  Children under the age of 5 shall not be permitted.
-  Dogs that previously have bitten or injured a person or another animal are not allowed.
-  All violations will be investigated and one of the possible penalties is revocation of use of the dog parks.
-  Use of the dog parks is a privilege and not a right.
