RECOMMENDED PARKING LOT TREES

BOTANICAL NAME	COMMON NAME	RECOMMENDED SPACING	RECOMMENDED LOCATION	COMMENTS
Columnar or Small Scale Trees:				
Acacia aneura	Mulga Acacia	15-25'	2	Best used as an accent or screen planting
Acacia stenophylla	Shoestring Acacia	20-30'	2	Better used in groupings for screening
Brachychiton populneus 'Majestic Beauty'	Bottle Tree	15-25'	2	Select single leader form only
Geigera parviflora	Australian Willow	15-25'	2,3	Tolerates reflected heat. Protect truck from sun
Washington filifera	California Fan Palm	15-20'	3	Better used as accent plantings in groups
Medium Trees:				
Eucalyptus microtheca	Coolibah Eucalyptus	25-35'	2	Best used when grouped to screen objects
Fraxinus velutina 'Rio Grande'	Fan-Tex Ash	25-35'	1,4,5,6	Semi-Evergreen, can have invasive roots and weakly attached branches
Olea europaea 'Swan Hill'	Swan Hill Olive	25-35'	2	Select single trunk form. Takes reflected heat
Quercus virginiana 'Heritage'	Heritage Oak	25-35'	1,4,5,6	Evergreen, slow to develop, honey dew drop problem due to susceptibility to heavy aphid infestations

BOTANICAL NAME	COMMON NAME	RECOMMENDED SPACING	RECOMMENDED LOCATION	COMMENTS
<i>Quercus muhlenbergii</i>	Chinquapin Oak	23-35'	1,4,5,6	Deciduous, red fall coloring. Note: new introduction
<i>Ulmus parvifolia</i> 'Drake'	Chinese Evergreen Elm	25-35'	1,4,5,6	Semi-Evergreen. Select Drake for upright branching form
Large Scale Trees:				
<i>Pistacia chinensis</i>	Chinese Pistache	35-45'	1,4,6	Deciduous. Unless well watered, tips of branches will have a tendency to die back. Good fall coloring
<i>Quercus fusiformis</i>	Escarpment Oak	35-45'	1,4,5,6	Evergreen, new introduction. Slow to develop
<i>Quercus ilex</i>	Holly Oak	25-35'	1,4,5,6	Evergreen, slow to develop but will get large
<i>Quercus suber</i>	Cork Oak	35-45'	1,4,5,6	Evergreen slow to develop. May need trunk protected until established
<i>Q. virginiana</i>	Southern Live Oak	35-45'	1,4,5,6	Evergreen. Species more rounded than 'Heritage'

Note: Rec. Location: refers to recommended planting site location in a parking lot area. For further tree layout information, refer to the Parking Lot tree layout plan.
